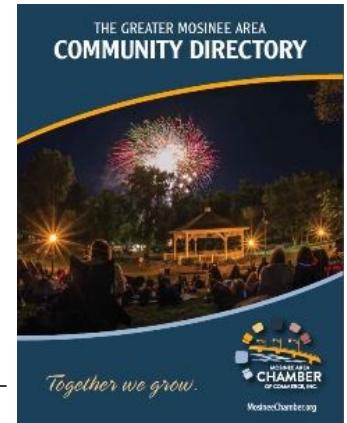

City of Mosinee News

At the June 8th meeting, the City of Mosinee Common Council approved a Downtown Building Improvement Grant Application for brick tuck-pointing and repainting of the exterior building located at 311 Main Street. The City of Mosinee would like to encourage other downtown commercial property owners to also take advantage of this grant incentive program!



The City Council also approved plans at the meeting for Crystal Finishing Systems, Inc. to construct a 3,116 s.f. equipment building addition to the north side of their facility located at 880 South View Drive within the Central Wisconsin Business Park. Crystal Finishing has already constructed a 28,800 s.f. addition to their building since purchasing it in 2013.

During a special meeting on June 22, the Council reviewed a proposed Street & Equipment Capital Financing Plan that includes the proposed reconstruction of a majority of the streets located within the Central Wisconsin Business Park. The Council will be considering the possibility of bonding for the noted street reconstruction projects and equipment replacement items during the Council's next meeting on July 13.

Mosinee's First Ever "Fireworks Grand Marshall" - Unique Opportunity

We tried something new! The Mosinee Area Chamber of Commerce sold tickets to become the first person in Mosinee to start the July 4th Fireworks display. The winner would be named "Fireworks Grand Marshall" and have a place in the July 4th Parade. **The winner would be the one to have the distinct honor of lighting off the "5 inch Artillery Titanium (Shell of Shells) Salute" that would begin the July 4th fireworks display.** Following this opening salute, the rest of the fireworks would automatically start, beginning with a short ground display of strobes with reflections in the water, then 150 nautical shells. This would be followed by hundreds of aerial fireworks. The best place to view the ground display would be, of course, in River Park

The "Fireworks Grand Marshall" would also have his/her picture in The Mosinee Times.
